

Administration A.06 United Way Appeal – PROCEDURES

- 1. By the end of May, the Director of Education shall select two co-chairpersons (one elementary principal/one secondary principal) for the United Way Employee Campaign held in the fall.
- 2. By the end of September, the Hamilton-Wentworth Catholic District School Board shall have in place an Employee Campaign Committee.
- 3. The Employee Campaign Committee shall be responsible for establishing campaign goals and objectives, setting a timetable, and conducting promotion activities during the campaign.
- 4. The Employee Campaign committee shall have representatives from schools, St. Charles Adult and Continuing Education, Nicholas Mancini Centre and all administrative buildings.
- 5. Representatives shall be responsible for:
 - attending the Representatives Organizational Meeting;
 - implementation of campaign requirements in accordance with timetable;
 - distribution of pledge cards/follow up;
 - distribution and displaying of United Way advertising/posters; and,
 - Reporting to Employee Campaign Chairperson.
- 6. When schools participate in fundraising for the United Way they shall direct the proceeds to a specific charity supported by the United Way whose mission is consistent with that of the Hamilton Wentworth Catholic District School Board. *Staff and student activity and financial participation shall be on a voluntary basis.* Parents will be informed of the specific charity to be supported by the event.
