POLICY STATEMENT

The Hamilton-Wentworth Catholic District School Board is committed to taking every reasonable precaution to ensure the health and well-being of all students and staff and to preventing serious medical emergencies.

This policy is for the use of an Automated External Defibrillator (AED), as an emergency device to aid a person during a life threatening medical episode as one method of immediate medical intervention.

Purpose

An AED is a portable electronic device that can audibly prompt and deliver an electric shock that will disrupt or stop the heart's dysrhythmic electrical activity. The shock can cause the heart to revert to a more effective rhythm during some life threatening situations.
