#### A.21 Student Use of Certified Service Animals in Schools

#### **POLICY STATEMENT**

The Hamilton-Wentworth Catholic District School Board (HWCDSB) is committed to the learning of all students and provides a range of differentiated interventions, placements and programs to support student success. It is the policy of the HWCDSB, in accordance with its obligations pursuant to the Ontario Human Rights Code (OHRC) to provide appropriate accommodation to students with disabilities to enable them to have meaningful access to education services.

In circumstances where a parent/guardian or adult student requests to have the student's Guide Dog/Service Dog/Service Animal accompany the student while attending school or a school-related event, each such request shall be reviewed on a case-by-case basis by the HWCDSB considering the student's dignity, inclusion, independence and disability-related learning needs as well as alternative accommodations available to enable meaningful access to education.

The process of accommodation shall consider the competing rights of other students and of staff; the impact of the Guide Dog/Service Dog/Service Animal on the learning environment; and the health and safety of all individuals who are or might be in the school, on school grounds or at a school-related event.

The HWCDSB shall retain data regarding the request for Guide Dogs/Service Dogs/Service Animals as outlined in the HWCDSB Administrative Procedures for Student Use of Certified Service Animals in Schools.

## Purpose

The purpose of this policy is two-fold:

- To comply with Ministry of Education Policy/Program Memorandum 163 School Board Policies on Services Animals (September 9, 2019); and,
- To ensure that students with disability-related needs are provided with accommodations which allow them full access the Ontario curriculum.
