B.M.01 Vandalism

POLICY STATEMENT

Vandalism, defined as willful acts of commission or omission leading to property damage or defacement of Board property (buildings, grounds, fixtures, equipment, etc.), will not be tolerated. Strong measures, including video surveillance, will be used to prevent vandalism and to assist in prosecuting such offences. Students implicated in vandalism incidents may be subject to suspension or expulsion from school. The Board shall seek monetary restitution, as permitted by law, from vandalism offenders (and/or their parents or guardians in the case of students). Efforts shall be made to impress upon students their positive role involved in reducing incidents of violence and vandalism in their schools. The cooperation of parents/guardians shall be sought in helping to minimize vandalism on school property.

Purpose

The policy is intended to convey to the constituents at each School Board property the Board's firm view of vandalism acts as incidents that must be prevented through community cooperation as well as deterrence through a defined set of consequences for such acts.

Responsibility

Associate Director of Corporate Services
Senior Manager Facility Management Services
The policy will be implemented at each site by the principal or site manager.
