B.M.04 Naming Schools/Administrative Buildings/Designated Areas within a School or Building PROCEDURES

<u>Schools:</u>

- 1. In the naming of a school each of the following will be invited to submit a proposed name:
 - a) the pastor of the parish where the school will be located;
 - b) the parents of the students of the new school;
 - c) the Trustees;
 - d) the Director of Education.
- 2. In the selection of a school name the Bishop of the Diocese shall be consulted and will have the option of submitting a school name. He will also have the option to make the final choice.
- 3. Names submitted by Catholic school ratepayers and Board staff will also be given consideration.
- 4. The exterior signage on schools will contain a cross and the name assigned to the school.

Administrative Buildings/Designated Areas Within A School Facility:

- 1. In the naming of such buildings or designated areas within a school facility, the proposed name shall be submitted to the Board of Trustees for approval.
- 2. The proposed name shall be acceptable to the Bishop of the Diocese.
- 3. The exterior signage will contain the name assigned as well as a cross.
- 4. An appropriate dedication of the name and blessing is to be conducted
