## S.03 Elementary School Students Out-of-Boundary Requests

#### **Policy Statement**

School attendance boundaries play a significant role for the Board to operate and maintain the system schools as effectively and efficiently as possible to support student achievement. The framework for the consideration of out-of-boundary requests, amongst other factors, reviews the availability of classroom space, the Ministry of Education class size regulation and most importantly, impact on student achievement.

## **Policy Supports**

S.03 Elementary School Students Out-of-Boundary Requests Procedures

## Purpose

The purpose of this policy is to identify the process for consideration of exceptions to elementary school boundaries. Exceptions may be granted to elementary students whose parents/guardians apply for this exception before the first day of school in September. Consideration for such a request shall not be granted until all in-boundary students have been accommodated.
