S.17 Dress Code/School Uniforms

Policy Statement

The Hamilton-Wentworth Catholic District School Board in keeping with the Board's Mission and Vision and Catholic social teachings requires that both elementary and secondary schools have a dress code and school uniform for the students.

Purpose

- 1. All elementary & secondary schools within the jurisdiction of the Hamilton-Wentworth Catholic District School Board shall adopt a mandatory school uniform policy.
- 2. Only a school logo/name shall be permitted on school uniforms. Advertisement of any kind on school uniforms is prohibited.
- 3. All schools shall have a signed contract with a supplier.
- 4. All suppliers of school uniforms must adhere to "The Sweatshop Free Purchasing Policy".
- 5. All elementary & secondary schools within the jurisdiction of the Hamilton-Wentworth Catholic District School Board shall adopt an appropriate dress code for students.
- 6. A school's student dress code shall be in keeping with the Board's mission and vision, and Catholic social teachings.
