## S.22 – Copyright – Fair Dealings

#### POLICY STATEMENT

It is the policy of the Hamilton-Wentworth Catholic District School Board to comply with the *Fair Dealing Guidelines* as developed by the Council of Ministers of Education Canada (CMEC) Copyright Consortium **this policy applies to all staff and students of the board.** 

To achieve this policy, the following apply:

- 1. The Board will communicate the *Fair Dealing Guidelines* to all school locations on an annual basis in order to ensure that all staff understand the obligations of the school board in accordance with the *Copyright Modernization Act;*
- 2. All new teaching staff will receive the Fair Dealing Guidelines and Copyright Matters! as part of the new teacher induction program; and,
- 3. The Fair Dealing Guidelines and consumables posters will be posted near all school photocopiers, scanners, print stations and other devices used to reproduce copyright-protected materials.

#### Purpose

The fair dealing provision in the *Copyright Act* permits use of a copyright-protected work without permission from the copyright owner or the payment of copyright royalties. The purpose of this policy is to ensure compliance with the *Fair Dealing Guidelines* as developed by the Council of Ministers of Education Canada (CMEC) Copyright Consortium.
