S.M.02 – Safe-Arrival Program for Secondary Schools

The mission of Catholic Education in Hamilton-Wentworth, in union with our Bishop, is to enable all learners to realize the fullness of humanity of which Our Lord Jesus Christ is the model.

POLICY STATEMENT

The Hamilton-Wentworth Catholic District School Board (HWCDSB) is committed to the safety of students within its jurisdiction; therefore, the HWCDSB has in place a Safe Arrival Program to inform parents/guardians of an unexplained failure to arrive at school.

To achieve this policy, the following apply:

- All secondary schools have procedures in place that are conducted in conjunction with daily school attendance-taking procedures and that aim to account for any student's unexplained failure to attend class through reasonable efforts to make timely contact with parents/guardians;
- ii) The school principal will ensure that details of the safe-arrival program are communicated broadly to parents/guardians and school staff;
- iii) Parents/guardians are responsible for communicating planned pupil absences or lateness to the school on a timely basis;
- iv) Parent/guardian reports of absence/lateness are to be reconciled with information obtained through classroom attendance taking procedures to identify any unexplained absences;
- v) Parents/guardians may report their child's absence by telephone, the SafeArrival Mobile App, or the SafeArrival web portal available through School Messenger;
- vi) Parents/guardians are responsible for providing the school with complete and current emergency information to enable the school to make any necessary follow-up contact;
- vii) The safe-arrival program is maintained by the school with advice from school councils, parents, and other community members;
- viii) The safe-arrival program should be flexible, with a view to achieving overall effectiveness and efficiency;
- ix) Procedures to investigate a situation where a student is deemed missing are established.

Purpose

A safe-arrival program is a system of procedures which are performed together with daily school attendance taking. Safe-arrival programs are a mechanism that parents/guardians and schools can use to account for any student's unexplained failure to arrive at school.

Responsibility: Senior Administration/School Principal
