POLICY STATEMENT

The Hamilton-Wentworth Catholic District School Board (HWCDSB) is committed to supporting students and families who have self-identified or self-reported a student pregnancy.

To achieve this policy, the following apply:

All board staff will promote open communication and will respond with respect and compassion toward the expectant student and family,

- i) Assist the student's decision-making by providing information and support in keeping with the Catholic faith;
- ii) Support the dignity of the student and the rights of the child in the womb;
- iii) Promote and advocate a plan to give birth;
- iv) Encourage the student to involve family members and others as appropriate (Pastor, Chaplaincy Leader, Social Worker, Catholic Children's Aid Society, etc.) in the decisionmaking process;
- v) Encourage the student to continue their education and to maintain their career plans.
- vi) Subject to the annual budget process, the Board will maintain distinct learning supports (e.g., St. Martins Manor, Regina's Place) for students who are pregnant.

Purpose

The promotion of life is consistent with the Catholic teaching that all life is sacred from conception. Part 3, Section 2270, "Life in Christ" of the Catechism of the Catholic Church teaches us that "Human life must be respected and protected absolutely from the moment of conception. From the first moment of his existence, a human being must be recognized as having the rights of a person - among which is the inviolable right of every innocent being to life."

This policy applies to all staff members of the HWCDSB who become aware of a student pregnancy.
