S.P.13 Home Instruction

The mission of Catholic Education in Hamilton-Wentworth, in union with our Bishop, is to enable all learners to realize the fullness of humanity of which Our Lord Jesus Christ is the model.

POLICY STATEMENT

The Hamilton-Wentworth Catholic District School Board (HWCDSB) provides home instruction to students currently enrolled in the HWCDSB who are unable to attend school due to medical related reasons. Home instruction provides academic support as a short term and time limited intervention.

Purpose

Home Instruction is intended as a **temporary** intervention; **it is a component of a documented plan that includes the student's anticipated date of return.** Home Instruction is not intended for an indefinite period of time, nor as an alternate mode of instruction delivery. A student of the HWCDSB is eligible for consideration to receive Home Instruction upon submission of a written recommendation by a physician and/or regulated health professional; the written consent of the parent/guardian, and the completion of the form, *Application for Home Instruction*, by the school principal. Parents/Guardians are provided with the *HWCDSB Home Instruction*. Home Instruction applications are subject to the approval of the Superintendent of education.
