POLICY STATEMENT

It is the policy of the Hamilton-Wentworth Catholic District School Board (HWCDSB), and consistent with Section 228 (2.1) of the Ontario Education Act, a member of the board who is absent for 20 consecutive weeks or less does not vacate his or her seat if the absence is a result of the member's pregnancy, the birth of the member's child or the adoption of a child by the member.

The Trustee shall provide the Chairperson of the Board with written notice of an absence of 20 consecutive weeks or less as a result of the Trustee's pregnancy, the birth of the Trustee's child or the adoption of a child by the Trustee. During this absence, the Trustee will continue to receive all notices, reports, minutes and communications.

Once the Trustee has provided this information a discussion will be had with the Chairperson of the Board regarding a plan of how:

- the Trustee chooses to remain engaged in the business of the Board. In addition to receiving all appropriate communications and materials, the Trustee may choose to participate, virtually or by phone, in committee and/or Board meetings;
- the work of any committee commitments will be completed; and,
- parent/guardian and ratepayer communication will be handled during the leave.

Purpose

Ensuring a trustee is given appropriate consideration during the time of the birth or adoption of a child is essential to support the fundamental dignity of the family and is consistent with the Mission and Vision of the HWCDSB.
