

H.W.C.A.A. PLAYING REGULATION 12.0
2006

TENNIS

1. AGES: Competitors must meet the age requirement as per H.W.C.A.A. Constitution By-Law 1. a). the individuals birth certificate indicates that he/she has not yet reached his/her 19th birthday by January 1st prior to the school year in which the competition is held.
2. EVENTS: There will be competition in the following events: Boys Singles, Boys Doubles, Girls Singles, Girls Doubles and Mixed Doubles.
3. ELIGIBILITY: Competitors must meet the eligibility requirements as per H.W.C.A.A. Constitution By-Law 1.
4. ENTRIES: No player may compete in more than one event. Each school may enter two teams or two competitors per event, depending on number of participants and venue(a maximum of 16 participants per school).
5. RULE BOOK: The rules of the Canadian Lawn Tennis Association will govern unless specified differently in this Playing Regulation.
6. OFFICIALS: Not specified.
7. UNIFORMS: Proper tennis apparel is required.
8. STARTING TIME: As per playing schedule (see H.W.C.A.A. constitution By-Law II.)
9. AWARDS: H.W.C.A.A. Championship
 - A) Gold medals- for each member of the winning team
 - B) Gold medals- for each event winner
10. G.H.A.C. REPRESENTATION: Not specified.
11. GENERAL REGULATIONS:
 - A) A school may enter a partial team.
 - B) The tournament will be arranged on a single elimination knock-out basis.
 - C) Consolation events may be run at the convener's discretion.
 - D) The convener has discretion to modify tournament conditions, e.g. length of matches. These changes shall not be contrary to the normal rules of lawn tennis.
 - E) The use of umpires and linesmen are up to the convener.
 - F) The convener or his /her designate shall act as chief umpire and his/her decisions shall be final.

- G) The Hamilton Catholic Championship will be held in the spring.
- H) Confirmation of entry (events) must be into the convener one Friday prior to the tournament.
- I) Operating expenses for the tournament (balls, court time etc.) will betaken care of by the office of the General Sports Convener.
