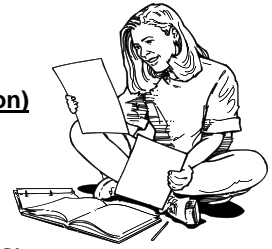
Courses may be dropped prior to the mid-term report, after which the Ministry's Full Disclosure Policy will be in effect.

ELIGIBILITY

Available to current Secondary School students with written permission from his/her day school principal or designate

ATTENDANCE

Prompt, daily attendance is expected. Students who incur more than 3 absences in a course or 1.5 absences in a half credit/transfer course may be withdrawn. Unacceptable behaviour and any infraction against the HWCDSB Student Code of Conduct may result in student being withdrawn from course.

FEES

- Foreign VISA students: **Full credit course - \$1,366.00; Half credit course - \$683.00** (cash or certified cheque only), is payable to St. Charles in full at time of registration. Refunds only if we cancel the class.
- Students that damage or vandalise school property will be held responsible for any and all costs associated with their actions, and may also be subject to criminal charges.

COOP/OYAP/SHSM

Students may earn secondary school credits through cooperative education (Coop), the Ontario Youth Apprenticeship Program (OYAP) or Specialist High Skills Major (SHSM). Contact the guidance office at your high school for information.

HOW TO REGISTER

- 1) **ON-LINE REGISTRATION:** Begins May 1, 2019 at <http://my.path.tosuccess.ca> for students of the HWCDSB. They must **Log in** using existing **MyPath account**. Once logged in to MyPath, students must select "School Courses" then "HWCDSB Summer/Night School", and then select the course and preferred location.

Registration for Non-HWCDSB students begins on June 1, 2019 - students will need to **create** a new account (BE ACCURATE) and fill out an Online Registration form (<https://via.hwcdsb.ca/>). Follow the QRC instructions found on www.stcharles.ca/ss. Bring your signed "Permission to attend" form with you to the first class (Download from www.stcharles.ca/ss). E-learning students must bring their permission form to the orientation night (Thursday June 12, 2019), or Bishop Ryan summer school office between July 2-5, 2019.

- 2) **ON-SITE REGISTRATION:** Only if you have NOT registered on-line, you can register at the Summer School location of your choice on Tuesday July 2 or Wednesday July 3, 2019 from 8:00 a.m. -2:00 p.m. You **MUST** have your signed permission form or high school transcript to register (Download from www.stcharles.ca/ss).

PLEASE NOTE: Report cards are mailed in August to the day school you indicate, make sure this information is correct.

Adult students: in addition to a high school transcript, you must bring your birth certificate or passport (or Immigration documentation if not a Canadian citizen) to register for Credit courses.

- If applicable, provide the Summer School office your Individual Education Plan (IEP) so we can better support your needs.
- **CHECK THE WEBSITE for Course cancellations, or changes to course locations on June 28 and July 2, 2019.**



TYPES OF PROGRAMS

New / Repeat Credit Courses

(Teacher-taught course codes end in “1” or “7”, e-learning** ends in “E”)

Available to current grade 9-12 students taking the course for the first time, or repeating (upgrading) a course (both run the same duration).
