## **About Immaculate Conception CES**

Immaculate Conception Catholic Elementary School moved into its new \$12-million, 64,500 square foot facility on Kitty Murray Lane on April 27, 2011 with an inaugural enrolment of 207 students, JK to Grade 7. An Official Opening and Blessing, held on June 5, 2011, was officiated by the Very Rev. Cornelius J. O'Mahony, Episcopal Vicar for Education for the Diocese of Hamilton. By September 2011, the school's enrolment had increased to 254 with the addition of a Grade 8 class and three Full-Day Kindergarten programs. The school's opening not only alleviated overcrowding at Holy Name of Mary Catholic Elementary School, but accommodated later development in Ancaster's South Meadowlands community. Designed by Svedas Architects Inc., the school features an oversized gymnasium, a ground floor Learning Commons, enhanced natural lighting and a prayer room, as well as hydration stations, state-of-the-art learning technologies, special classroom auditory aids, and advanced electrical and mechanical systems for minimal energy use. The school's name, Immaculate Conception, completes Ancaster's saintly triad – St. Anne and St. Joachim, parents of the Blessed Virgin Mary, born of Immaculate Conception.
