RULES

- COACHES MUST SEND SCORES TO ON-SITE CONVENOR IMMEDIATELY AFTER EACH OF THEIR GAME
- Each team will play three 30 min. games (2 of which will be back to back to simulate closer to a full game)
 - Regular full-field rules will apply (including substitutions on your own throw-in and piggy-backing).
 - No game shall end in a tie. Sudden death shoot-out will determine a winner. All players on the field (including the goalie) must shoot before you can repeat shooters.
- 3 points for a win, 2 points for a shoot-out win, 1 point for a shoot-out loss, 0 points for a straight loss
 - All teams will make play-offs, and will be put into two divisions to play-off for a championship and a consolation championship (only champion will receive medals). Teams will be ranked at the end of pool play by points.
- If any teams are tied at the end of pool play, head to head will be used to determine the winner. If a three-way tie occurs the following will be used to determine a winner: most wins between the three teams, goal differential (overall, with a max of +/- 4 per game), coin toss/draw from a hat. Once the winner is chosen, the ranking of the next team will be as if there were two teams tied.
- Semi-final games: if ends regulation time in a tie. Sudden death shoot-out will determine a winner. All players on the field (including the goalie) must shoot before you can repeat shooters.
- Championship game: if finishes regulation time (30min) in a tie, three shooters will be chosen from the players on the field for a shoot-out. If still tied, will go to sudden death. All players, including the goalie must shoot before you can repeat shooters.

Pool A will play 45 minute games and Pool B will play 30 minute games. This will allow for all teams to have a total of 90 minutes in round robin play.
